# From Pastor Hansen

---

## *After All This...*

*“But God proves his love for us in that while we still were sinners Christ died for us.”*

Dear Friends in Christ, Grace and peace to you from our Lord and Savior, Jesus, the risen Christ. Amen.

As many of you know, I have been writing a daily devotional based upon the sayings of Jesus in the gospel of Matthew. It has been an interesting journey for me. I have had to spend my days looking at lots of sayings of Jesus that are sometimes hard to hear. I have to admit that I like writing on some of the sayings, but not so much on the sayings that are difficult to hear. I think they are difficult because I find myself in them all too much. When I hear about what Jesus has to say about being a disciple or what it costs to be a follower, I feel guilt. I feel guilty because I know, deep in my heart, that I simply don't measure up. I am not trying to say that if I could get back to the disciples' faith things would be better. I think it is simply too difficult to make my way to faith as a follower of Christ. I am too often more interested in what best suits me. I want to have it all and still live as a disciple. I want people to love me and I want to love others and sometimes those things come in direct competition with each other. Why?...because, I love my self generally before God and certainly before others. Maybe that is why I like the season of Lent so much. It allows me to spend some time during the season pondering this dead end road that my self-service draws me down. Lent is a sobering reminder of where this self-serving love gets me. It is a road that leads me to the cross where I see Jesus hanging there, and to be honest, a realization that I have put him there. Of course it is not literally true, but much of my life ignores what he has to say, to understand what it means that God loves me, and by that fault am somewhat happy to see him up there.

And yet, after all this...he is raised from the dead on that Easter Sunday morning and death is defeated. No longer can it have a hold on me. No longer can my deceptions get in the way. After all of this, I am claimed as God's child. It is an inheritance that should surprise me every day when I open my eyes and try to push Murphy off of my covers and give a wink to Lisa. After all of this turning away from God, living for myself, and striving to have it all, God still welcomes me back. This is what makes Easter such a surprise! This is why I continue to love the drama of Holy Week. I deserve nothing, yet on Easter Sunday, I gain everything! Why does it take this season to remind me something I should live into each day? This is what I will try to ponder more often.

My friend, John Ylvisaker, was the pioneer of Lutheran contemporary music. He had tremendous talent for giving words and music to theology and lives of faith. He had a great sense of humor and wryly used it on me more than once. His most famous piece of music is sung often in our churches. “I Was There to Hear Your Boring Cry,” is its title, and I can imagine the surprise even he discovered as God welcomed him home this past month. Every day is a surprise. Thanks for that remind-

er, John. May you be surprised by the good news of Easter morning this year, as you hear those life-giving words, "He is not here. He has arisen!" Thanks be to God.

# Worship & Music

## Lent, Holy Week, the Resurrection, and Franz Joseph Haydn

This month we conclude the season of Lent with the final Wednesday Lenten services on April 5, Palm/Passion Sunday on April 9, Maundy Thursday on April 13, Good Friday on April 14, and the Vigil of Easter on April 15. Think of worship on Thursday, Friday, and Saturday not as separate services but as one large service spanning three days. Note the directions to enter or leave in silence and the absence of preludes and postludes. Here in this service, too large for one day, we come to the centrality of our faith, what God in Christ has done for us.

**Fun Fact:** Franz Joseph Haydn and Pastor Tim Hansen share March 31 as their birthday.

**Challenge:** We are not performing the Credo (the Nicene Creed). In the Nelson Mass Haydn himself omitted two phrases from the *Credo*. Which phrases are they?

On Sunday, April 16 we celebrate the triumph of life over death. We will celebrate with the good news of the Resurrection of Our Lord and lift our voices with brass instruments, timpani, organ, guitars, and drums. Let everything that has breath praise the Lord!

That brings us to Sunday, April 23. Typically the Sunday following Easter Sunday becomes a “down” Sunday. NOT SO AT OUR SAVIOR’S! On Sunday, April 23, at 10:30 the Senior Choir, together with vocal soloists from the University of Wisconsin, plus strings, trumpets, organ and timpani under the direction of Mark Lehnowsky will present the *Missa in Angustiis* by Franz Joseph Haydn (1732-1809).

This “Mass in Time of Anxiety or Constraint” was written in 1798, a politically unsettled period in European history, dominated by Napoleon’s campaigns against the Austro-Hungarian empire. The Austrian government had been unable to control inflation, leading Haydn’s patron, Prince Nicolaus, to introduce a number of household economies, including the dismissal of eight woodwind and horn players. No longer having these musicians, Haydn wrote what would have been their parts for the organ. Unknown to Haydn, and at the same time, the English navy under Lord Nelson scored a decisive victory over the French in the Battle of the Nile. News of that, however, didn’t reach Vienna until much later. Nelson visited Eisenstadt (just outside Vienna) in September 1800 and this Mass is believed to have been performed then. The *Missa in Angustiis* is now popularly known as the “Nelson Mass.” Musically, this Mass represents the culmination of Haydn’s creative career in which he created an impressive synthesis of traditional Austrian baroque music with his mature symphonic style.

For our worship at 10:30am on April 23, the parts of Haydn’s “Nelson Mass” will be performed as parts of the service with the *Kyrie* and *Gloria* near the beginning, and the *Sanctus*, *Benedictus* and *Agnus Dei* at the time of the Lord’s Supper. On April 23 the “Nelson Mass” will replace our contemporary worship service.

Please mark your calendars, plan to attend this very special service, and invite your friends.
