2018 ELCA Youth Gathering Registration Now Open!

Every three years the ELCA hosts a national gathering for all current 8th-12th graders. That means this is a HUGE event with 30–40,000 people attending! You do not want to miss this event! *Registration is open now through November 8th, 2017.* After November 8th, registrations may not be accepted and your cost will go up. We will be traveling with our entire synod by coach bus departing on Tuesday, June 26th, 2018. Also plan to attend the synod pre-gathering retreat at Lutherdale Bible Camp with our group (April 27-28, 2018). The total cost for this trip and the pre-gathering event is approximately \$1000 per person; however, OSLC has a strong history of fundraising for youth trips especially the national youth gathering. We already have our fundraisers planned out and ready to go and our goal is to prevent you from having to pay more than \$325. A sign-up sheet is located at the Welcome Desk. *We ask that you pay a deposit of \$325 when you sign up in order to reserve your spot on the trip.* Please drop off your check with Matt Weber or the front office.
