Luther's Catechism in Hymn: The Sacrament of the Altar Martin Luther wrote the hymn *Jesus Christ, Our Blessed Savior* to explain and teach about communion. The hymn appeared in print in 1524. Luther loosely based this hymn on a Latin hymn by the earlier Bohemian reformer John Hus.
